The Genesis

India is amongst the largest public education and health delivery systems in the world, the roadblocks to deliver services to communities efficiently is not a meagre challenge.

One of the key barriers to an efficient delivery system is the preparedness and readiness of service deliverers i.e., government officials to perform their job well. The public education and health ecosystem does not provide government officials with adequate stimulation and motivation, nor does it lay emphasis on tapping and building their leadership skills. The result is creation of a cadre of officials who do not feel motivated enough to stretch their abilities and maximize their own potential. This holds true not just within education but extends to other government departments as well, including health, thereby impacting the quality of services they are able to provide to the people they serve, i.e., the communities.

Children for example, the beneficiaries in education are confined to the four walls of the classroom, with content confined to language, math, and science focusing on rote learning, and thus a lopsided focus on academic outcomes. The role of education is to offer pedagogy that not only catalyzes acquisition of application-oriented multidisciplinary skills but also 21st century skills essential for children to thrive in future societies and workplaces.

Piramal University was born out of a pressing need to fill these gaps. The individual schools of learning are in themselves centres of excellence in their respective domains



The School of 21st Century Education aims to provide cutting-edge curriculum to students and support to teachers through state and district institutions to pole-vault the 100-year learning gap. It seeks to motivate millions of children to attend school across India by focusing on 21st century education through implementing SEEL (social emotional ethical learning) PISA-skills, Livelihood Education, Aesthetic Literacy and Physical Literacy.

School of Systems Change aims to create trustworthy public institutions with high-performance service cultures through solutions that improve organizational focus on outcomes that matter, supported by the right person in the right job at the right time. It does this through equipping the 21st century systems leaders with skills in governance, automation, legal reforms, communication and public finance, via a combination of classroom sessions, live action projects, and peer learning communities.

School of Transformational Leadership aims to develop future-ready and sewa bhaavoriented public systems leaders who drive innovation and learning. It seeks to build motivated leaders and enhance their ability to perform duties to their potential through helping them transform their practices, and supporting them through tools and frameworks to remain motivated and inspire others around them via a leadership curriculum that unlocks individual potential and sewa bhaav.

The Journey so far
