- Lead and manage specific components or workstreams within the supply chain management activities of the adolescent health program, ensuring alignment with NHM program
- Provide technical leadership and expertise in key areas such as procurement planning, warehousing, distribution, and inventory control.
- Support NHM program budgeting, financial planning, and utilization tracking for adolescent health and SRHR initiatives.
- Analyze fund flow mechanisms and recommend strategies to strengthen finance efficiency and accountability.
- Facilitate coordination between finance, procurement, and program divisions to ensure smooth disbursement and utilization of funds.
- Build and maintain strong relationships with government counterparts at the state and district levels.
- Provide technical assistance and capacity-building support to NHM and partner staff on SCM, budgeting, and expenditure tracking.
- Lead assessments of existing supply chain systems, identify bottlenecks, and recommend evidence-based improvements.
- Oversee implementation of innovative SCM solutions, including digital tools and best practices for efficiency and transparency.
- Contribute to the development of project reports, proposals, and presentations for donors and government stakeholders.
- Represent the project in relevant state and national forums, workshops, and review meetings.
- Ensure compliance with project policies, donor requirements, and national/state financial regulations.
- Support monitoring and evaluation efforts, including developing indicators and analyzing financial and SCM performance data.
- Undertake regular field visits to review implementation, provide technical guidance, and troubleshoot financial or SCM issues.
- Support program budgeting, utilization, and process streamlining in coordination with NHM and public health departments.
